ADOPTION OF TEXTBOOKS</p> <p>It is the responsibility of the Board to adopt all textbooks used for instruction in the educational program of this district.</p> <p>For purposes of this policy, textbooks shall be defined as those books which are purchased in classroom quantity or more and which are issued to each student in the class.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall be responsible for the selection and recommendation of textbooks for Board consideration. No adoption or change of textbook shall be made without his/her recommendation, except by a two-thirds vote of the Board.</p> <p>The Assistant Superintendent or designee shall develop and implement a plan for the selection of textbooks.</p> <p>Guidelines for selecting textbooks include the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Professional staff members shall participate in the selection process. 2. Textbooks currently in use shall be periodically evaluated for their continuing usefulness and relevance. 3. Parents of students, preferably at the grade level of the textbook recommended for adoption, shall be involved in the review process of textbook selection. 4. Textbooks recommended for adoption will be available for general review for one (1) month prior to being recommended to the Board. <p>A list of all approved textbooks shall be prepared and maintained. It shall be reviewed annually for the use of the professional staff, for the information of members of the Board, and for the information of students, parents and community.</p>
