ASSIGNMENT WITHIN DISTRICT</p> <p>The Board directs that the assignment of students to classes and schools within this district be consistent with the proper educational needs and ability of students and best use of district resources.</p> <p>The Board shall determine periodically the school attendance areas of the district and shall expect the students within each area to attend the school designated. In assigning students to schools within this district, no discrimination shall occur.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall periodically review existing attendance areas and recommend to the Board changes that may be justified by:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Considerations of safe student transportation and travel. 2. Financial and administrative efficiency. 3. Effectiveness of the instructional program. <p>The Superintendent or designee may assign a student to a school other than that designated in the attendance area when such exception is justified by circumstances and is in the proper educational interest of the student.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall assign incoming transfer students to schools, grades, and classes that afford each student the greatest likelihood of realizing full educational potential.</p> <p>The building principal shall assign students in his/her school to appropriate grades, classes, or groups. This action shall be based on consideration of the needs and abilities of the student as well as the administration of the school.</p> |
