223. USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES	
1. Purpose	The Board regards the use of bicycles and motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents and students.
2. Authority	<p>The Board shall permit the use of bicycles by students in accordance with district rules, provided that students have been granted permission by the building principal to ride a bicycle to school.</p> <p>The Board shall permit the use of motor vehicles by secondary students in accordance with district rules.</p> <p>The Board shall not be responsible for bicycles or motor vehicles which are lost, stolen, or damaged.</p> <p>On July 20, 1973, the Bureau of Traffic Safety from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation determined that the roads leading to the secondary campus are classified as a “hazardous walking condition.” Due to this designation, students without bus stops along the immediate entrance to campus are not permitted to walk onto the secondary campus. Failure to abide by this regulation will result in appropriate referral under the school discipline system.</p>
Pol. 218	No currently enrolled Seneca Valley student will be allowed to park on public roads near the secondary campus for the purposes of attending a regularly scheduled school day or after hours school event. Failure to abide by this regulation will result in a Level 1 offense under the Student Discipline Policy (Policy #218).
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent or designee shall develop rules and regulations for operating and parking bicycles and motor vehicles and shall disseminate those rules to all students so affected.
