RELATIONS WITH EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS</p> <p>The district in which students are in attendance has the responsibility and authority for them. In order for those students to receive maximum benefit from their program of studies, articulation between the cooperating institutions is essential.</p> <p>It is the policy of the Board that lines of communication be maintained by the district with other districts and institutions which provide programs, training or services not otherwise available to district students and with districts whose resident students are enrolled in programs of this district.</p> <p>It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent or his/her designee to maintain open communications with such educational institutions.</p> <p><u>Receiving District</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide annually a complete description of all programs available to students of the sending district(s). 2. Provide an orientation program for incoming students from sending districts. 3. Assure that unusual traits of individual students entering this district have been made known to the staff members who could be of most assistance. 4. Inform the sending district of any serious discipline problems encountered with students from their district. <p><u>Sending District</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Establish programs to ensure that students of this district are properly prepared to enter the schools of the receiving district.

Establish appropriate student accounting procedures to satisfy district and state requirements in the areas of enrollment, attendance, transportation and other special services.2. Maintain liaison with the administrators of private and parochial schools in order to be aware of any planned program changes that could affect this district. <p><u>Institutions of Higher Education</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Welcome representatives of institutions of higher education who wish to speak to students interested in attending their institutions upon completion of secondary education.2. Cooperate in the placement and evaluation of practice teachers in accordance with Board policy on student teachers.3. Honor all proper requests for transcripts and other records in accordance with the Board's policy on student records.
