

AUTOMATED ATTENDANCE SYSTEM

The Seneca Valley School District utilizes the “Phone Master Notification System.” This is an automated calling system that will make a telephone contact for every student on their day of absence. Please note that tardy students who arrive after the Phone Master process has begun may still be notified by phone. Parents/guardians will receive an automated call between the hours of 9:45 AM – 10:30 AM for elementary students and between the hours of 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM for secondary students.

The purpose of this program is to improve communications between the home and school, ensure student safety and emphasize the importance of regular school attendance. Participation in this system is mandatory for all Seneca Valley students.

You must select and record your contact number at the bottom of this page. You need to decide whether this is a home, neighbor, work, relative number or the number of your daytime care provider. The system will leave messages on an answering machine but cannot contact you via beeper or dial an extension. If the number you choose is not your home or a direct line, please make sure the person you list is aware of our system.
