

Second Grade Daily Summer Activities

Provide Time

- Make sure that your child has a quiet time for practice. The practice session should be short and positive. Consider your child's personality and other activities as you decide how to schedule daily practice periods.

Provide Materials

- Your child will need a quiet place to work. Put extra writing and drawing paper, scissors, crayons, pencils, and a glue stick in a tub or box. Store the supplies in the work area you and your child choose.

Provide Encouragement and Support

- Your response is important to your child's feelings and success. Keep your remarks positive. Recognize the effort your child has made. Correct mistakes together. Work toward independence, guiding practice when necessary.
