

Uniform Care and Responsibilities - POM PONS

Each Pom Pon member is responsible for the following:

- Check uniform & other items for damage, regularly. Indicate any damage (such as stains, fabric damage and wear) on the *Uniform Receipt Acknowledgement* form, to be completed annually. If damage occurs during the season, promptly report it to the coaches and the uniform committee.

Proper Uniform Care:

- Properly hang the uniform on the hanger. following every performance.
- Handwash uniform in cold water with Woolite following every performance.
- Do not dry-clean!!
- Do not wring or twist.
- Lay flat to air dry.
- Do NOT dry the uniform in a dryer. The heat from home & commercial dryers can damage the uniform and will result in the student being required to replace the uniform.
- Only food provided by the band boosters may be consumed while in uniform.
- Garment bag is to be used to store only the uniform.
- Wash garment bag in cold water and hang to dry. Do this at least once a year.
- Raincoats must be completely dried, both inside and out after use. They also must be refolded into the storage pocket.
- Uniform must be returned **cleaned** and in good condition.

Dress for Success (aka REQUIRED uniform attire):

- Hair must be in a ponytail with a scrunchie.
- White boots/cleaned.
- A leotard must be worn under the uniform but not visible during the performance.
- No jewelry or nail polish (except clear and white tips) may be worn.
- Tights must not have snags &/or holes.

Replacement cost for damages due to negligence is as follows:
